**Howard Kotchie**

Howard Kotchie was a Team Canada member from 1988 – 1997 and represented Canada at both World and American Zone championships.

He was part of the history making event during the American Zones Championships in Wichita, Kansas in 1989 as one of the first players to bowl a perfect 300 game along with a competitor from Mexico.

During international competition Howard won three silver and two bronze medals for Canada. In 1992 Kotchie was named Canadian Male Bowler of the Year.

As a member of the Greater Toronto Tenpin Bowling Association Howard was named to the Greater Toronto All Star Team (6) times and Bowler of the Year for the GTTBA in 1979 and 1989.

He earned provincial scratch titles as well as the national Pins Game championship. He was champion of the Rochester, New York, Lilac Scratch Tournament in 1999.
